ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

Blitz is a low odor, super concentrated, high-powered stripper that rapidly penetrates and strips off floor finish. A powerful solvent combined with amines, penetrates and removes multiple coats of floor finish with minimum labor. Blitz's low odor formula is ideal for use in areas where odors are a concern. This high productivity floor stripper removes floor finishes completely with one pass and then rinse and neutralize with Pro AP Rinse. This unique formula provides the lowest end-use cost per gallon due to its ultra-concentration.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT ON WOOD FLOORS OR PAINTED SURFACES.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Sweep or dust mop the floor to remove any debris.
- 2. Simply add one 1/2 gallon bottle per mop bucket.
- 3. Apply the stripping solution liberally using a mop or automatic scrubber. Allow to stand for at least 5–10 minutes. Do not allow the stripper solution to dry. Be sure to completely cover floor to baseboards
- 4. Scrub with a rotary floor machine or automatic scrubber equipped with stripping pads.
