CARPET BONNET CLEANER

ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

This product is a proprietary blend of a low foaming, encapsulating surfactant, organic acids, water conditioning agents and optical brighteners. It is a highly effective bonnet cleaner designed to aggressively clean all carpet types without harming the fabric or any stain resistant properties that may exist.

The area to be cleaned should always be vacuumed and free of debris before bonnet cleaning. After the bonnet cleaning process has been done and the carpet is completely dry, the area should be vacuumed again to remove the encapsulated soils. This product can be used by either pre-spraying the area to be cleaned with the diluted product in a pump up sprayer or by soaking the bonnet in the diluted product and then wringing out before use. Although bonnet cleaning is a low moisture process, a fan should be used to help the surface dry. Always make sure that the surface is completely dry before allowing regular traffic back into the area.

A color fastness test in a hidden area should always be performed before extraction on colored carpet and fabrics.

DIRECTIONS

Dilute at a rate of 6-8 ounces of product per gallon of water.

Pre-Spray Method: Pre-spray the carpet with the diluted product in a pump up sprayer or with a truck mount sprayer. Only spray approximately 200 sq. ft. at a time. Soak a bonnet in fresh water and then wring out until it is slightly damp. After the bonnet has become soiled on both sides, re-soak and wring out.

Pre-Soak Method: Soak a clean bonnet in 5 gallons of diluted product. Wring the bonnet out until it is slightly damp. Use the bonnet to clean approximately 200 sq. ft. and then flip it over. After the bonnet has become soiled on both sides, re-soak and wring out.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Prevention: Wear eye protection/face protection. Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Wear protective gloves. **Response:** IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor/medical professional. IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Specific treatment (see section 4 on the Safety Data Sheet).
