# For Toploaders:

12# to 20# 1/8 to 1/4 Cup

35# to 50# 4 to 6 ounces

75# to 100# 8 to 12 ounces

125# to 200# 12 to 16 ounces

Wash in warm not hot water. Best results are achieved in wash temperatures between  $100 \text{ to } 120^{\circ}\text{F}$ .

**RECOMMENDED USES:** Towels, Uniforms, Linens, Sports Laundries, Hotels and Motels, Shirt Laundries, Presoaking, Laundry processing aid for removal of troublesome protein based soils.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
