ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

Powerful Metal Safe Detergent that cleans thoroughly even on the dirtiest of dishes. Water conditioning agents suspend food particles and prevent scale build-up which can affect machine function and damage delicate parts. The product is packaged in a dispensing jar designed to fit into a powder dispensing bowl and kept dry until it is fed into the machine. Once the product is emulsified with water the chlorine and alkaline are activated immediately. This product is dispensed at a low feed rate causing it to be extremely economical.

DIRECTIONS

Consult your Service Representative for specific use directions. Your Service Representative will set your dispensing system at the correct and most economical operating level so that cost-effective concentrations are maintained during all cycles. To use, remove tab from screen lid and place canister into dispenser screen lid down. DO NOT remove canister until completely empty. To remove, lift from dispenser carefully and turn upright to avoid spills. Use tab from new screen lid to seal used canister. Put old canister in container for waste disposal.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Prevention: Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Do not eat, drink, or smoke when using this product. Do not breathe dust or mists. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection.

Response: IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor/medical professional. Specific treatment: See section 4 on the Safety Data Sheet. Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
