



# Orange Power Concentrate

## D-LIMONENE DEGREASER

### ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

All natural citrus cleaner, degreaser, deodorant, de-scaler and decloger. Contains no chlorinated solvents. Orange Power is 100% environmentally safe. May be used safely on carpets, sinks, toilets, fiberglass, machinery, tools, grills, ceramic tiles, concrete, graffiti, dumpsters, grease traps, all metals, and more.

### DIRECTIONS

**For Cleaning /Deodorizing:** Dilute 2 to 4 ounces of Orange Power per gallon of warm water. Sponge or spray onto surface and allow to stand a few moments. Then wipe with a clean cloth or sponge.

**For Machinery, Engines, Rubber Burns, Graffiti and Heavy Industrial Cleaning:** Dilute Orange Power 6 ounces per gallon of warm water. Mop, spray or sponge onto surface and allow to stand at least 5 minutes. Then scrub or brush thoroughly and rinse with clean water.

**For Toilets, Sinks, Urinals, Shower Stalls, Bathtubs, Chrome Fixtures and Ceramic Tiles:** Dilute Orange Power 2 to 4 ounces per gallon of water and apply to surface, allow Orange Power to stand for a few moments and then rinse.

**For Grease Traps:** Add 6 ounces weekly to all drain openings and allow to stand at least 10 minutes before flushing.

**For Carpets, Rugs, Upholstery and Fabrics:** Dilute Orange Power 6 oz of per gallon of warm water. Apply with sprayer or clean cloth. Do not over wet. Gently work out stain and blot with clean cloth.

**For Odor Control for Dumpsters, Garbage Disposals, Septic Tanks, Sewage Plants, Kennels:** Dilute 4 ounces of Orange Power per gallon of water. Spray or mop onto area and let stand.
