ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Do not dilute. Use product directly from the container.
- 2. Test for color fastness in an inconspicuous area.
- 3. Apply P.O.G. to a clean, white absorbent cloth.

4. Blot area working from the outside of the spot and moving towards the center.

5. Blot area with a clean white cloth.

6. To ensure no residue remains, clean area using a quality detergent or blot with a volatile solvent.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Prevention: Keep away from flames and hot surfaces. No smoking. Wear protective gloves/eye protection/face protection. Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Response: In case of fire: Use water fog, foam or carbon dioxide (CO2) to extinguish. Call a POISON CENTER/doctor/medical professional if you feel unwell.
