DIRECTIONS

Home Run Powdered Wash is an aggressive fast-acting all purpose powdered vehicle wash. This formula is designed for cleaning all types of vehicles.

Home Run removes: Baked-on Road Film, Bugs, Heavy Soils

Home Run works well in: Coin Operated Systems, Tunnel Washes, High Pressure Washers, Mobile Power Wash Applications, Truck Wash Bays

Recommended on: Cars, Trucks, Trailers, Tractors, Heavy Machinery

Dilute 7.5 to 15 lbs. per 55 gallons of water.

For High Pressure Systems: Meter at 48:1 to 75:1 depending on the intensity of the soils, road film and bugs.
