ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

LockNLoad 113 Lavender Vanilla Deodorizer can be used on fabric surfaces such as upholstered furniture and carpeting. Use sparingly. Spray lightly wherever offensive odors are to be controlled. Spray in enclosed non-traffic areas. For outdoor areas such as garbage dumps, sludge beds, incinerator pits, etc. spray over the entire area. Use sparingly. Amount to be used varies with the intensity of the malodor. In refuse cans, garbage containers, truck beds, etc., spray before filling with debris. For best results also spray around the sides and over the contents.

DIRECTIONS

Insert container into the LockNLoad Dilution Station. Lock the container into place by sliding the blue lock to the left. This locks in the container and connects it to the Dilution Station. The Dilution Station is set to properly dilute the concentrate with water.

To fill small containers by using the short hose on the right side of the Dilution Station. Insert the short tube into your container and push up on the container to activate or push up on the grey button on the face of the Dilution Station. To fill a large container, use the long hose on the left side of the Dilution Station. Place the hose end in the container and push the button on the black gas pump style handle. (hose does not automatically shut of when container is full).

LockNLoad products are designed to be used with the LockNLoad Dispensing Station. The product should be loaded into the Dispensing Station and locked into place. Using the Dispensing Station will ensure that the concentrate is diluted correctly at 64:1. One gallon of LockNLoad Concentrate makes 64 gallons of ready to use product.

The grey dilution lock in the opening of the container should never be removed. If the dilution lock has been removed, the contents of the container and the container should be properly disposed of.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Prevention: Wear eye protection/face protection. **Response:** If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.
