### ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

Mud Remover is an ingenious solvent designed to remove both inorganic and organic deposits from storm and sanitary sewers. Sewer commissioners find that it is specially effective in the removal of mud and accumulated sanitary sewage, thus increasing the sewage flow.

Mud Remover chemically releases the adhesive and cohesive forces by which organic and inorganic deposits cling to the sewer walls. The fine particles of old mud and sewage become fluffy and are easily dispersed.

### DIRECTIONS

Use 1 gallon of Mud Remover per 1000 gallons of pumping water when using a fire hose or hydraulic jet pump to clean sewers.

Mud Remover can also be poured into a manhole or sewer opening at the rate of 1 gallon per 100 ft. of 1 ft. diameter pipe. Following this application of Mud Remover, the normal flow of sewage after the next rain will wash out the loosened deposits.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**Prevention:** Wear eye protection/face protection. **Response:** IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER/ doctor/medical professional.
